Mohan Pilla conceived & developed this 4 evening program in 2010, when it was first launched. He is a Singapore and UK qualified dispute resolution lawyer with nearly 30 years' experience in advisory, commercial litigation and regional arbitration work, particularly in construction and engineering projects.

Mohan is a Chartered Arbitrator and the first Review Adjudicator appointed under the adjudication regime in Singapore. He is currently the Co-Chair of the Dispute Resolution & Arbitration Committee, Inter-Pacific Bar Association (IPBA). His past appointments include President of the Singapore Institute of Arbitrators, Chair of SCL (Singapore) and the International Construction Projects Committee, IPBA, as well as teaching appointments as Adj. Assoc. Professor, Facult of Law, National Universit of Singapore (2003 - 2011) and Visiting Professor, Centre of Construction Law & Dispute Resolution, King's College London (2005 – 2011). He is one of the General Editors of Singapore Construction Adjudication Review and the Singapore Journal of Construction Law, and co-author (with Toh Chen Han) of "The SICC Handbook – A Guide to the Rules and Procedures of the Singapore International Commercial Court" (Sweet & Maxwell, 2016).

Chen Han's area of practice is Dispute Resolution. He focuses in particular on construction, engineering and commercial disputes, and related advisor work. The cases on which Chen Han has acted involve a range of matters including tracing and restitution of monies, conspirac, expresswa design and construction, power plant design, construction and operation, cargo-facilit construction, water works, mixed research and commercial developments, and hotel management disputes.

Chen Han obtained his degree in Jurisprudence from Oxford Universit (Balliol), and is called to the Singapore bar. As Partner in Pinsent Masons' construction disputes and advisor division, and Council member of the Societ of Construction Law (Singapore), Chen Han regularl speaks and teaches on issues that concern the Construction industres both in Singapore and internationall. Chen Han has written for various publications such as the International Construction Law Review. He co-authored the chapter on Enforcement of Foreign Judgments and Foreign Arbitral Awards in the Law and Practice of Commercial Litigation in Singapore (Sweet & Maxwell, 2015), and has (with Mohan Pilla) recentle co-authored "The SICC Handbook – A Guide to the Rules and Procedures of the Singapore International Commercial Court" (Sweet & Maxwell, 2016). He is also a Contributing Editor for the Singapore Journal of Construction Law.
